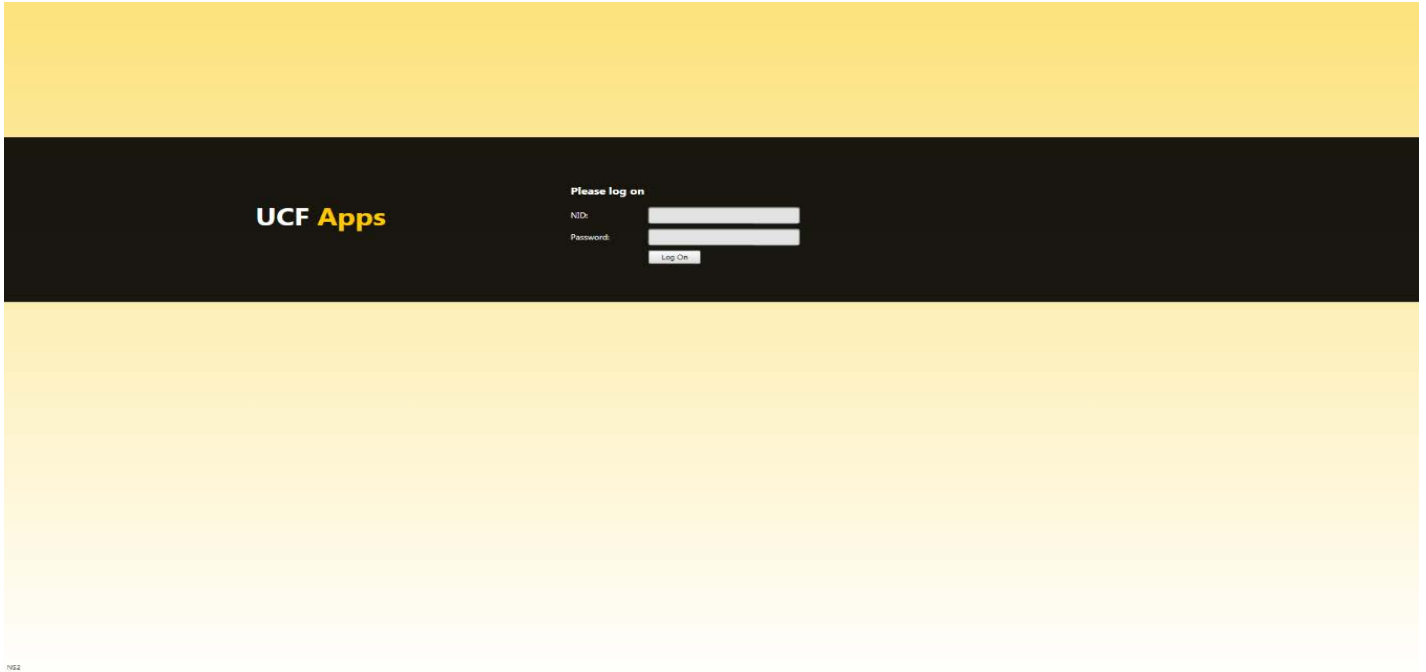


How to Install UCF Apps

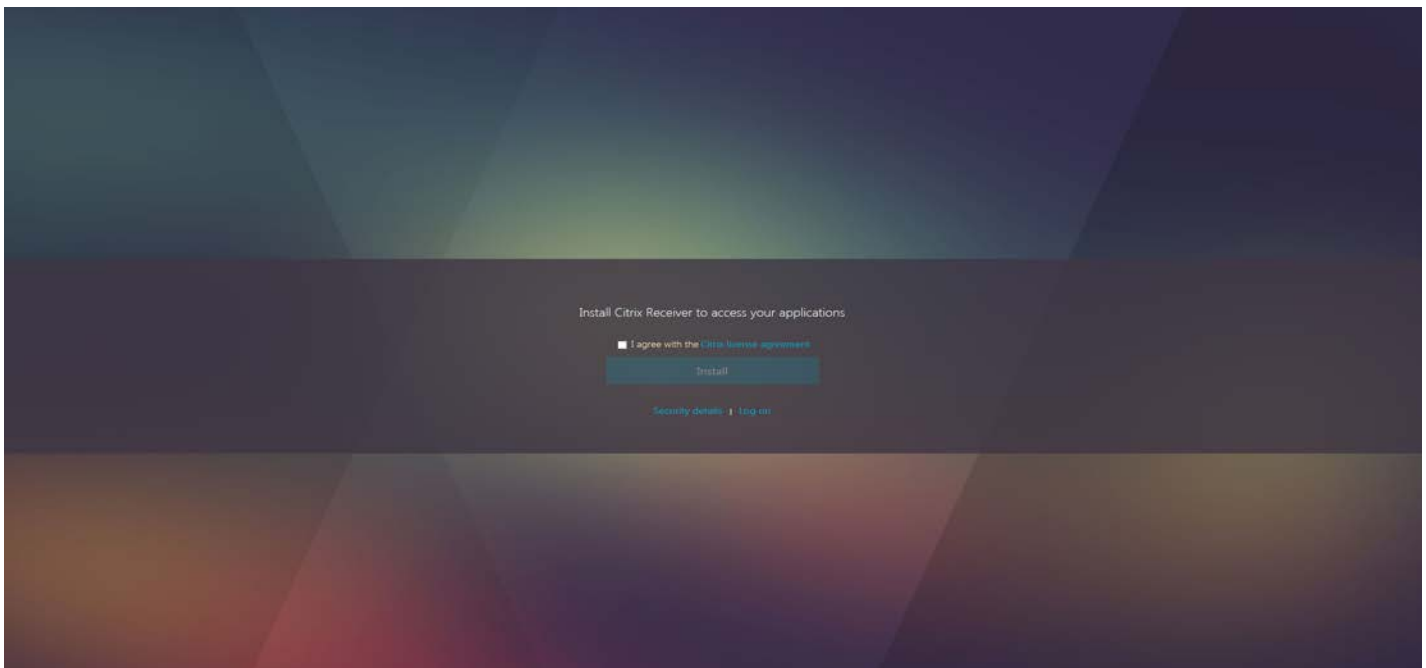

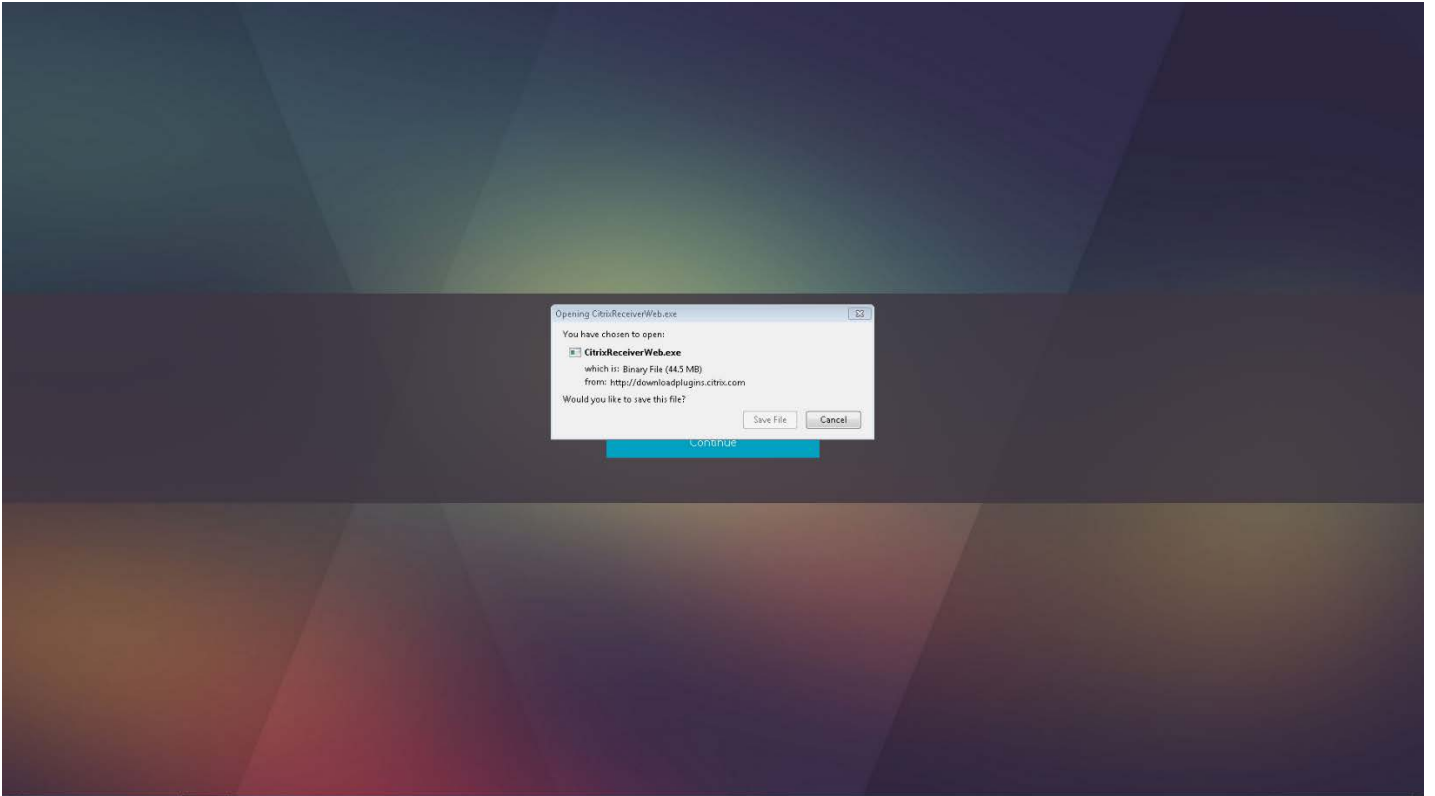
Login in with NID and NID Password



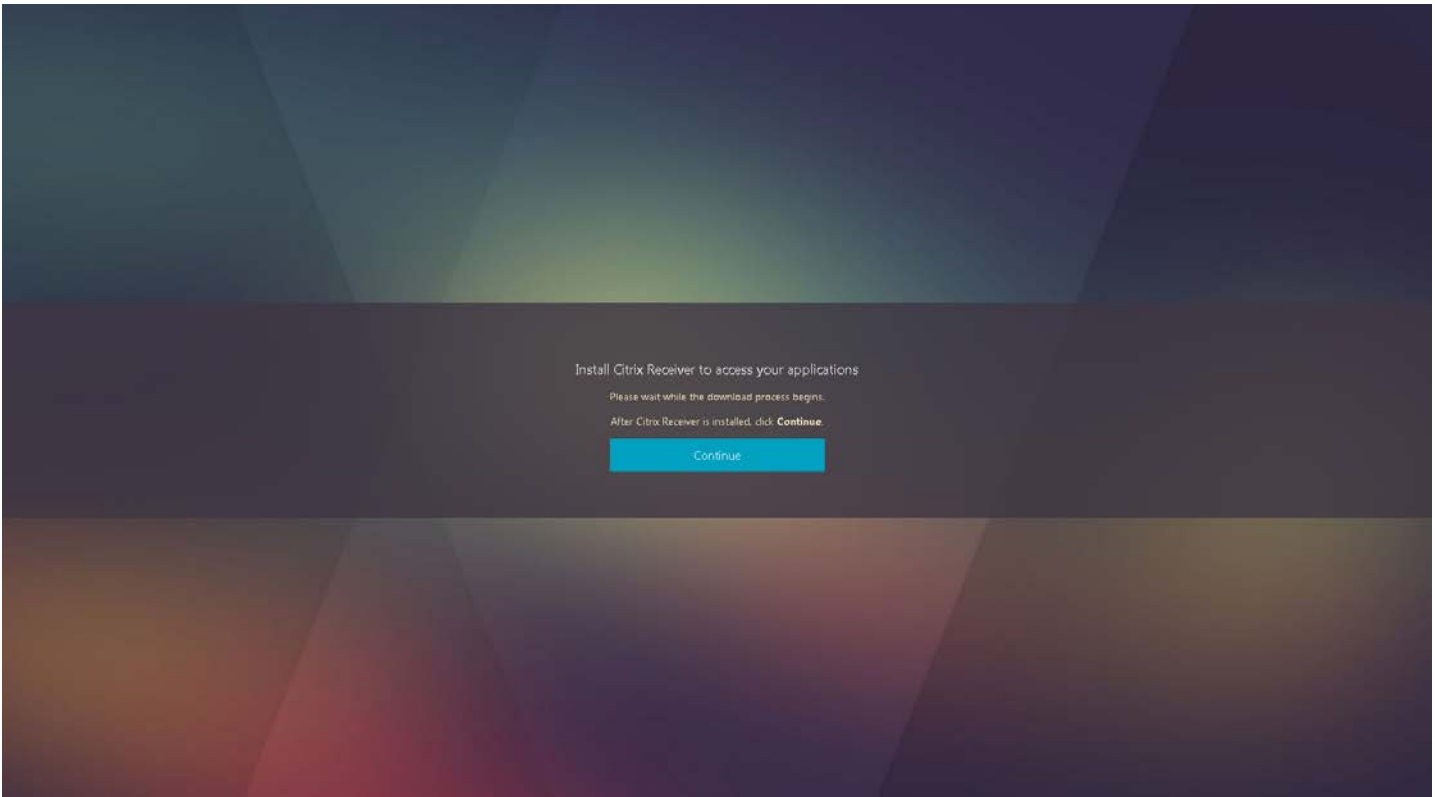
Check: I agree with the Citrix License Agreement and click install.




