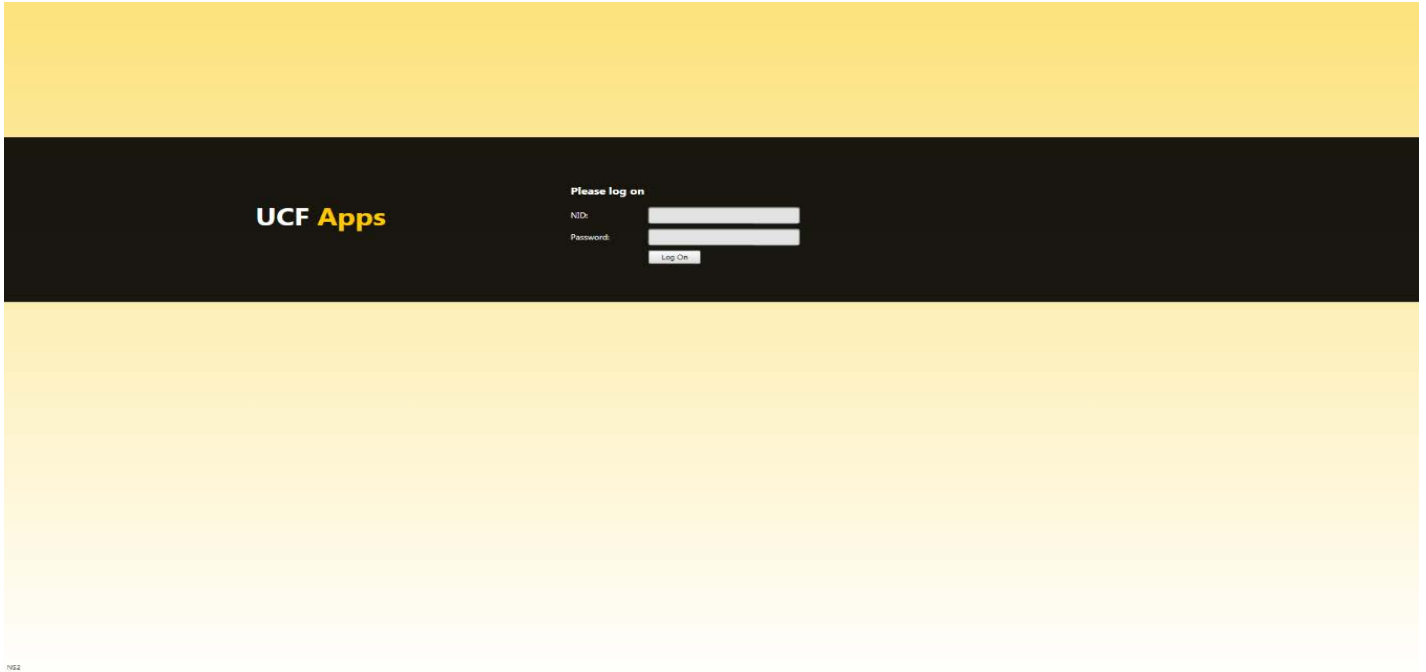


# How to Install UCF Apps

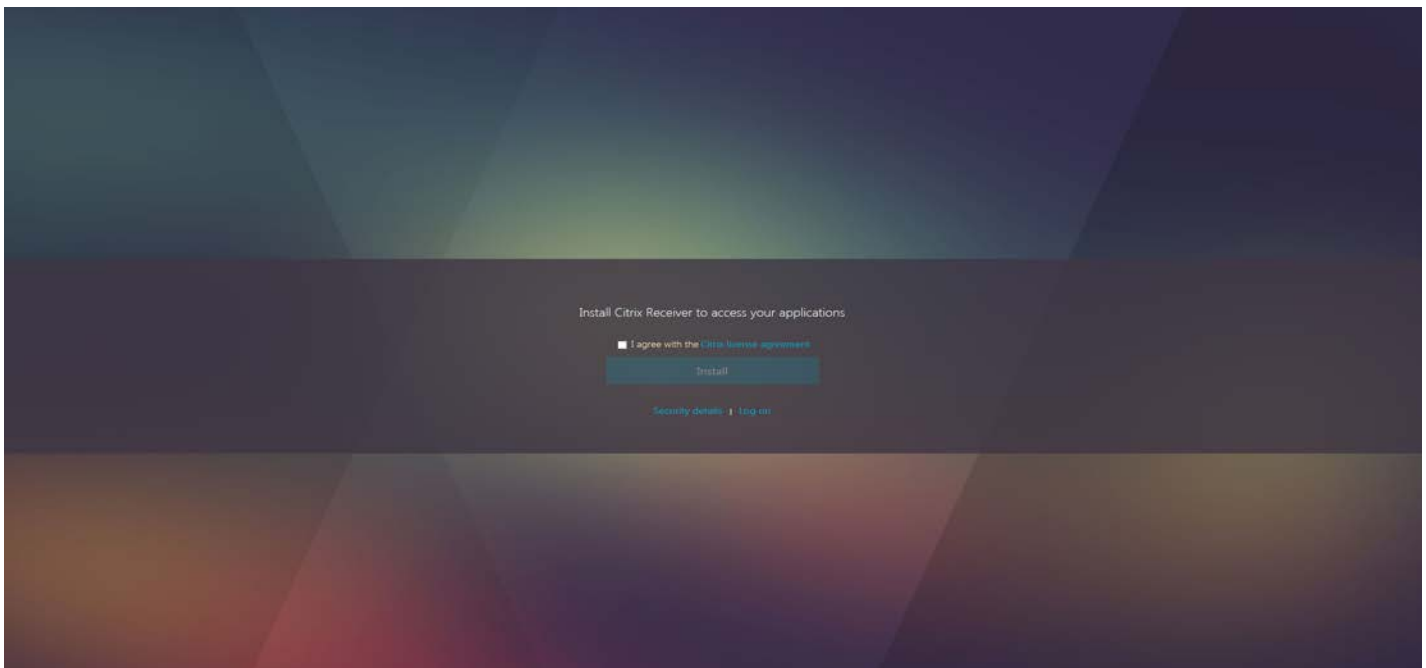

Go to: <https://my.apps.ucf.edu/>

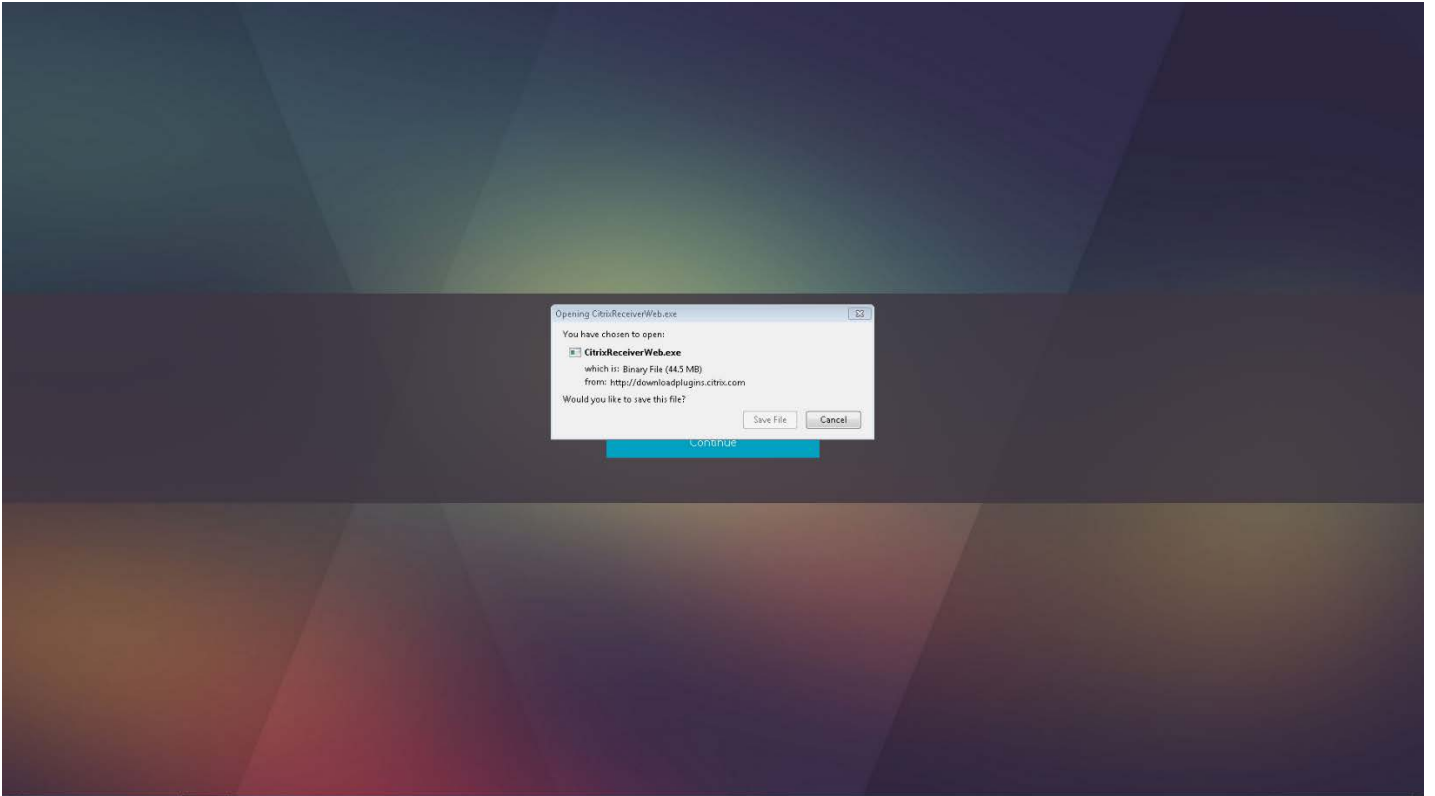
Login in with NID and NID Password



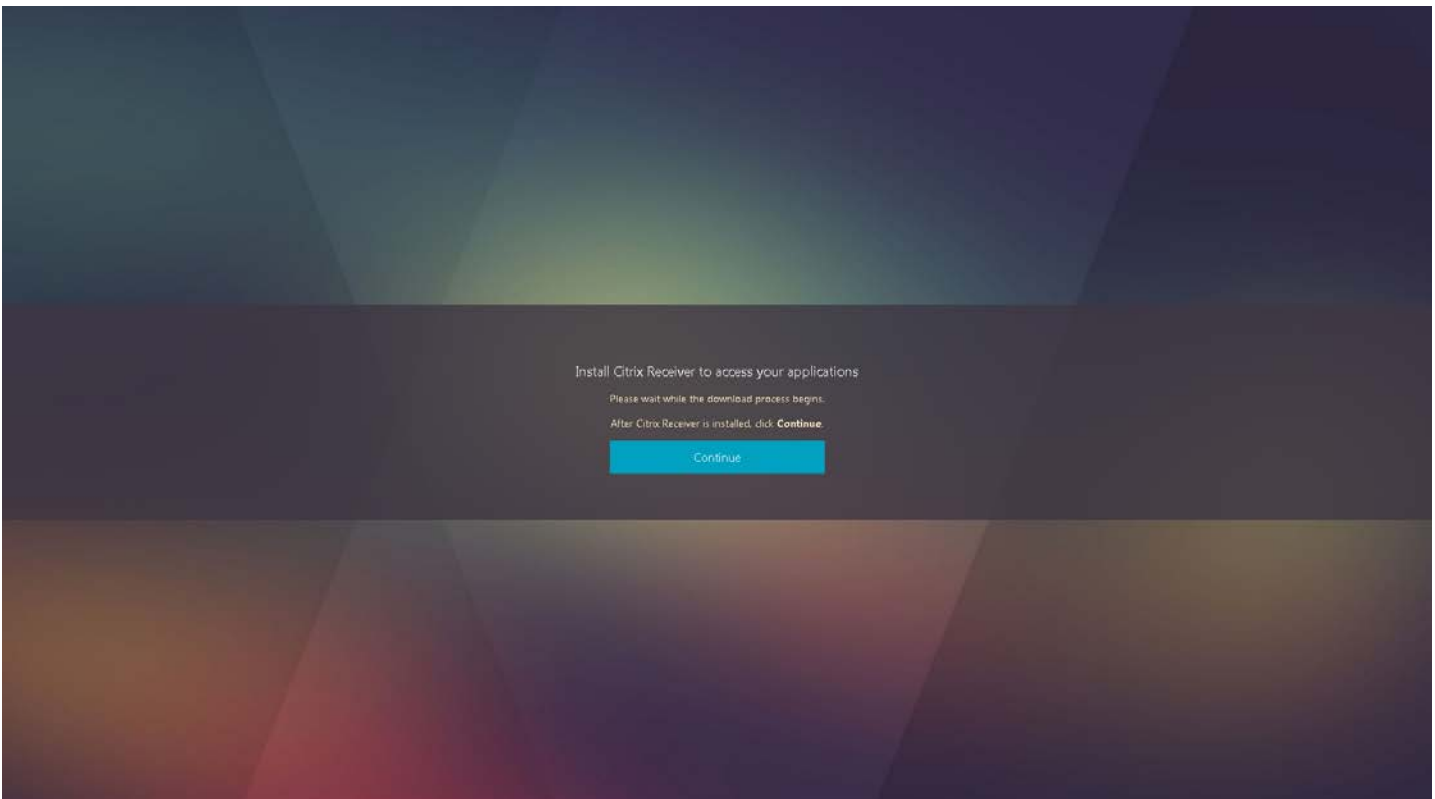
Check: I agree with the Citrix License Agreement and click install.




